Dear Parent/Guardian

I would like to take this opportunity to update and inform you of the arrangements for the Year 11 Prom. This year's Prom will be held on Thursday the 27th June 2019 at Twycross Zoo and tickets can be bought once all invitations have been sent out.

The Prom is a privilege that we would like as many Year 11 students as possible to partake in. In order for your son or daughter to receive their invite for the Prom they must comply with three simple requirements:

- They must achieve 100% attendance between the dates given below
- Students must have no entries on the behaviour log nor behaviour points for the dates given below
- Students must also not receive more than three late marks between the dates given below

Students will have four opportunities to achieve their Prom invite; the first round of invites will be awarded during the week beginning 7th January 2019 for students achieving the above between 5th September 2018 and 21st December 2018. The second round will be awarded during the week beginning 25th February 2019 for students meeting the above requirements between the 7th January 2019 and 15th February 2019. The third round of invites will be awarded the week beginning 29th April 2019 for students achieving the above between 25th February 2019 and 12th April 2019. The final round of invites will be awarded the week beginning 4th June 2019 for students achieving the above between 29th April 2019 and 24th May 2019.

Students will have the opportunity to increase their attendance percentage by attending a variety of after school revision sessions, which will be calculated and any final invites will be awarded at the fourth round stage. I would strongly advise that no student makes arrangements for the prom until they receive their invite; if a student's behaviour and/or attendance declines after receiving their invite they will have their invite revoked.

I am sure you will agree that the criteria to earn a Prom invite is a basic requirement especially for students about to undertake their GCSE exams.
