The GCSE course in MFL

At TQEA, students in Year 9 can opt to continue with either French or Spanish to GCSE level.

- ❖ The course includes 4 skills (Listening, Reading, Writing, Speaking)
- ❖ All 4 skills are worth 25% of the grade.
- ❖ At TQEA we follow the AQA exam board.
- ❖ You will complete a speaking assessment which is examined by your class teacher and a listening, reading and writing exam in June of Year 11.
- ❖ We will support students to achieve their target grades by offering:
 - ☐ Lunch time support sessions
 - ☐ After-school support sessions
 - ☐ One-to-one sessions for personalised support
 - ☐ Past papers in lessons
 - ☐ Vocabulary tests in lessons
 - ☐ Consistent use of the target language by teachers and by students.
 - ☐ Revision programs designed by MFL teachers in the final term before the exam
 - ☐ Regular contacts with parents/carers
