Safer Schools is an app designed to support and protect children by educating and empowering them both at school and at home. Through their log-in (see below), your children get access to information that is relevant to them and you will receive tips and advice on how to keep them safer online. It is a simple go to app on your phone and your child's phone which gives easy access to informative videos, the latest safeguarding information on all aspects of well-being and e-safety and it is pitched at it's audience. I use it as a training vehicle for all staff at TQEA too.

Once you have downloaded the app using the relevant QR code below, you will be asked which school: The Queen Elizabeth Academy. You then enter the appropriate code for you. Make sure you download the app as well as ensuring your child does
