

TQEA Uniform

A reminder of our uniform standards for those of you replacing items over the summer break.

Socks - should be plain full ankle socks (black, grey or white), not sports/trainer style socks. There should be no visible skin between the sock and the bottom of trousers.

Skirts must be smart and professional and must be made of loose fitting material and not Lycra or other tight fitting, body con or stretch material. Inappropriate skirt length will be challenged and will need to be addressed immediately.

Undergarments should be an appropriate colour to protect modesty e.g. neutral or white vests, bras etc.

Some students are also starting to wear trousers that are not full length or are made of a legging, jegging or jean like material - this is not acceptable. Please be vigilant when buying trousers as many companies sell trousers in their school section that are not acceptable at TQEA.

Please be reminded that visible logos, air bubbles, canvas or cloth trainers and pumps are not allowed. Shoes must be black leather throughout. Again - please don't be caught out by shops that sell shoes in the school section that do not adhere to our uniform policy.
