Duke of York (iDEA) Award Scheme

We are launching the Duke of York digital enterprise award for the first time this year to year 7 students.

To gain the Bronze Award students must undertake a set of digital tasks to earn 40 credits. The tasks cover a variety of e-safety and cyber security topics while linking with topics from across the curriculum. Once 40 credits have been gained the student will receive an official certificate sent from Buckingham Palace.

This is a free opportunity which will allow students to learn new skills and enable them to learn how to be a good digital citizen as well as providing them with an award which they can add to their college applications and CV’s later in life.

Work towards the award will take place in a choice of sessions depending on numbers, these sessions will be a combination of lunch and/or after school to accommodate everyone.

As your child is under the age of 13 parental permissions are required to access the course therefore a parental email address is needed for each student to enable parents to give consent.
