Summer School information

Firstly, we would like to thank you for expressing your interest in your child attending our Summer School. As previously communicated, the Summer School will run from **Monday 9th to Friday 13th August from 9am until 3pm each day.**

Our Summer School will support pupils making the transition into Year 7 who have had an extremely disrupted end to primary education and potentially missed valuable preparation for their secondary education. We recognise that some pupils are likely to need additional support with English and Maths intervention to help them access the secondary curriculum, and see this week as an important opportunity to support pupils' wellbeing during this important transition.

We will be including enrichment activities, such as team games, music, art, and STEM in addition to a daily English and Maths session. Pupils are allowed to wear their own clothes, but as they will be participating in a range of activities, they must ensure they are suitably dressed.

This Summer School will be a fantastic opportunity for your child to participate in many activities, and help them form positive relationships with their peers as well as staff from TQEA before the start of Autumn Term. The cost of providing a summer school this year is being met by the Department for Education, therefore, there is no cost to parents/carers for this and lunch will be provided (free of charge) as part of the offer.
