Dear Parent/Guardian

I would like to take this opportunity to update and inform you of the arrangements for the Year 11 Prom. This year's Prom will be held on Thursday the 30<sup>th</sup> June 2022 at The Western Hall Hotel, Bulkington, from 6:30 – 11pm (final price of the ticket is to be confirmed ASAP – approximately £30).

The Prom is a privilege that we would like as many Year 11 students as possible to partake in. In order for students to receive their invite for the Prom they must comply with three simple requirements:

- Students must achieve 90% + attendance between the dates given below. (Absence for COVID is not included in the %.)
- Students must not receive more than two behaviour points (2 x C2's, 1 x C3 or C4) during the dates below.
- Students must attend at least one intervention session every week.

**Students will have three opportunities to achieve their Prom invite:**

- **Invite 1** – Spring Half Term 1 (4<sup>th</sup> Jan – 18<sup>th</sup> February) – Completed.
- **Invite 2** – 15<sup>th</sup> March to 1<sup>st</sup> April - Current
- **Invite 3** – 4<sup>th</sup> April – 6<sup>th</sup> May - Final

Please be aware that if there is a decline in a student's attendance or behaviour, SLT are entitled to revoke their invite.

I am sure you will agree that the criteria to earn a Prom invite is a basic requirement, especially for students about to undertake their GCSE exams and for them to achieve as well as they can. To celebrate with Pride after working exceptionally hard in their final year and allow an opportunity to finish the year on a real positive. ***All students have an opportunity to get their Prom invite.***

The non-refundable deposit of £15 is required by **Friday 25<sup>th</sup> March through ParentPay or cash given to the office.** this has been previously promoted with Year 11 students via email during the past weeks.
