GCSE History Berlin residential visit Friday 28th - Monday 31st October 2022 (end of October half term)

Following feedback from students and parents about the cost of the Berlin trip, I have found an alternative quote with slightly different dates. I hope this is more affordable and more students are able to attend.

As part of the 'Germany 1890 – 1945' section of the GCSE History course, we are excited to offer the opportunity to visit Berlin in October 2022. Berlin is a fascinating city, full of history, and we firmly believe that seeing sites in 'real life' rather than just in the classroom really helps to make History memorable and will support students in their GCSE History exams.

The approximate cost of this trip (it may go up or down slightly once flights and excursion tickets are confirmed) is **now £525 per student** and includes:

- All coach transfers in the UK and Germany
- Flights from London Heathrow to Berlin Brandenburg
- Three nights accommodation in Berlin, including breakfast and dinner, in en-suite dorm rooms
- Visits to relevant museums including the Topography of Terror, the Jewish Museum, the German Historical Museum and the 1936 Olympic Stadium
- A guided tour round the Reichstag (parliament) building
- An excursion to Sachsenhausen Concentration Camp museum and memorial tour

If you would like to reserve a place on this trip, we need a £150 deposit by **Friday 20th May 2022**. The payment of the balance can be made in monthly installments of £100 via ParentPay, with the final payment in September to be adjusted to reflect the final cost.

Please note that all students will need a valid passport and will need to be double vaccinated for Covid, as current travel restrictions demand.
