An exciting opportunity has arisen for Year 10 students of Media and Art to discover the film-making magic of The Wizarding World of Harry Potter. Your son or daughter will explore the iconic sets, costumes and props from the film franchise, gaining an insight into the incredible skill and talent that went into producing the films. Alongside the tour, students will take part in a lesson, learning how the Production Designer tackles a script brief, examining the process from sketch, into storyboard and model, resulting in the final set. We hope that the whole day will support and enhance your child's appreciation of film production and design, as well as inspire them to further explore the Media, Film and Art career opportunities available to them.

The visit will take place on Monday 23rd May 2022. Students will travel by coach, leaving school at 8.45am and returning at approximately 5pm.

Currently, the total cost of the trip is £36.50, which includes travel and ticket costs. However, we are currently seeking funding from our Trust to cover travel costs, which would take the total payable amount to £19.50. Should travel costs be required at a later date we will let you know.

To secure your child's place on the trip, please pay a deposit of £19.50 to cover ticket costs via ParentPay by Thursday 16th December.

Students will be required to wear school uniform as they will be representing the school and for safeguarding reasons. We advise that students bring their lunch and/or some extra money should they wish to make any additional purchases in the shop or restaurants. Free School Meal students will be able to collect a packed lunch before they depart.
