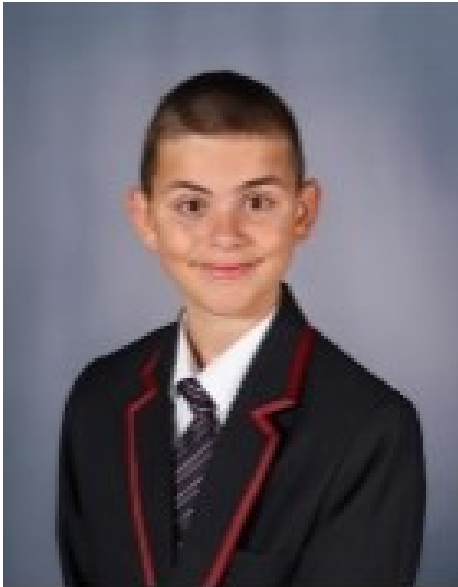
We wish our Year 11 the very best of luck as they enter the second week of their examinations next week.
