

This year we have relaunched our character values program, good character is fundamental, as it contributes to humans flourishing. We have 4 key values that underpin all for the work done int eh academy, these are

Pride • Endeavour • Resilience • Kindness

During the year pupils will be learning about how important these values are, and how to apply them at school, at home and in the wider community. Each week we will be sharing more information on social media.

Pride

Noun | a feeling of deep pleasure or satisfaction derived from one's own achievements, the achievements of those with whom one is closely associated

Endeavour

Verb | to try hard to do or achieve something

Resilience

Noun | the capacity to withstand or to recover quickly from difficulties; toughness:

Kindness

Noun | the quality of being friendly, generous, and considerate

During their return to school pupils learnt about famous people who have displayed these values in their lives, they included Nelson Mandela, Mother Teresa and Albert Einstein, all of whom can be found on the academy walls.


